

Structure of Ostomy Associations in Australia

- Ostomy supplies are paid for by the Australian Government
- Supplies are distributed via 20 non-profit Stoma Associations
- ► The Government pays a fee to the Stoma Associations to distribute products
- ► The Associations are all members of The Australian Council of Stoma Associations Inc. (ACSA).
- ► ACSA monitors the scheme and is the main contact with Government.

Ostomates in Australia

- Approximately 50,000 ostomates Australia wide.
- ► Government spent A\$103.8 million on products for ostomates in 2022
- Stoma Associations to distribute products in 2022

Stoma Associations in Australia

- Purchase and supply products to Ostomates
- Ostomates choose their Association
- Most associations have volunteers and receive donations
- ► The boards of the associations are ostomates
- Associations provide extra services including:
 Stoma Nurses, Information (newsletters, website etc), information days

Ostomy Medical in Australia

- ► Government supports surgery, chemo, radiology
- Stomal Therapy Nurses mostly employed in hospitals.
- Some Stoma Associations employ a Stomal Therapy Nurse for their members' support
- Stomal Therapy Nurses pay for their own specialist training

Features of the Australian Situation

- ► Good communication with Ostomates as all must get supplies through associations
- Committed boards (all ostomates) and staff in non-profit associations with focus on members.
- Funding getting tighter as Government support has not increased in many years
